

# Village of Johnson Water & Light Department

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED TARIFF CHANGES

On April 16, 2010, the Village of Johnson Water and Light Department filed a request with the Vermont Public Service Board (PSB) for an increase to retail rates of 18.00%. The over-all increase in costs for the Electric Department is due largely to the increased costs of supplying and distributing energy to the consumer. The proposed retail rate increase is to be effective on a service rendered basis beginning June 1, 2010.

To determine the impact on your individual bill, use the proposed rates column and your average monthly consumption. For example, a residential customer using 600 kWh a month would calculate his or her bill as follows:

The Public Service Board has no authority to suspend the rate increase request. If the Board decides not to open a formal investigation, the rates will take effect June 1, 2010, on a permanent basis. However, if it appears to the Board that the rates may be unreasonable, the Board may order a formal investigation and hearing on the proposed rate changes. Until completion of the formal review by the Board, the increase will be listed as a surcharge on your bill.

Any interested person may examine the rate increase filing at the office of the Public Service Board or at the Village of Johnson Water and Light Department offices during normal business hours.
