

DRIVEWAY STANDARDS:

- 1) The need for and size of culverts shall be determined by the Road Commissioner and or the Road Foreman. Minimum culvert size shall be 15" X 30' and shall be approved by the Road Commissioner and or Road Foreman.
- 2) A minimum of 10" of gravel or crushed stone shall be placed over the top of the culvert.
- 3) The driveway shall be constructed so that water and runoff does not enter the Town highway. Snow removed from drive cannot be placed in Highway.
- 4) The Town of Johnson assumes no responsibility for anything placed in the Highway right of way, i.e. mailboxes, signs, fences, driveway markers, etc.
- 5) Driveways must be designed and maintained for safe sight distances and traffic safety. If signage is required, signs shall be provided by the applicant.
