Jeanne applied to Turrell for a \$6000 grant. We should hear results in December.

Jeanne handed out copies of the architect report from 12/14/12, which targets repairs that could be done to improve energy efficiency. She will also contact Kneeland Masonry related to looking at brick repairs on the front of the building.

Stacey reports that Duncan stated our budget concern would be brought up at the Select Board meeting. Stacey will plan to attend the meeting to discuss the \$2000 discrepancy.

It was suggested that a letter be sent to the Village Trustees to ask if they have investigated options for a crosswalk by the library.
