

Johnson Recreation Meeting Minutes

July 2, 2018

Members Present: Kerri O'Halloran, Hillary Hoag, Heather Rodriguez, Michelle Boyden, Suzanne Dodge

The selectboard has approved \$2,500 for the repair of the Pavillion Building in Mill Park from the Recreation Reserve Fund. Heather believes that a less expensive solution is possible and will discuss with Brian Story. If a less expensive option is available, the committee would like to go with it.

The selectboard authorized \$2,135 for the purchase of new soccer goals. These are for 3" goals. Tim Sullivan would believe that 4" goals would be more durable and a better investment. They cost an additional \$720. The committee agreed to spend that \$720 from the current year's budget.

Soccer registration opens on July 15. The cost will be \$30 per child + a uniform deposit.

Agata asked Eden about their scholarship policy. Apparently, they do not have one. Fees are waived upon request, at the discretion of program organizers. Brian Story was going to post on a statewide message board asking other towns what their scholarship policies are. We have not gotten word back from him. Heather will follow up with him.

Heather reports that we've had 96 boulders delivered to Mill Park for lining the parking areas. She consulted with the mowers to verify that they need a minimum of 60" between rocks to mow between them. We have spent \$800 on rocks and \$800 on trucking. We discussed how to place rocks to ensure access for emergency vehicles and maintenance. The consensus of the group is to leave gaps in strategic places for access. If this proves ineffective, we can look into gates. Nat will discuss this with Brian Story.

Nat will ask Brian Story about the status of hiring Heather as the Rec Coordinator.
