Cambridge Youth Soccer offered to organize fall soccer for the county. We agreed that there would be advantages to that but there are too many unknowns for it to happen in the fall of 2015. We will continue to organize it as we have in the past. But continue the discussion with CYS with the potential for greater collaboration in the future.

We will reach out to people who might be interested in coaching Johnson Youth Soccer this fall.

Soccer Registration will be \$20 per child (\$35 family cap until school starts and then increase to \$25 (with a \$40 family cap) after school starts.

We agreed to contribute up to \$200 for road signs directing people from Main Street to Mill Park and the LVRT Trail Head.

We agreed that the baseball scoreboards on Legion Field should be removed. This is not our top priority. When we get volunteers to do it, the signs will come down.

We agreed to put "Please Leash Your Dog" and "Please Scoop the Poop" Signs in Mill Park.

We support the removal of the "No Dogs Allowed" sign in Legion Field. Nat will bring this to the Selectboard.

Nat will research the purchasing of trashcans for Mill Park.

The Committee agreed to offer financial support to the elementary school for the renovation of the basketball court on the school playground. We also voted to oppose the removal of the court from school grounds.

We agreed to make a Facebook post in support of Amy Longe Langlois's family and a link to their gofundme page. Beth will ask Cal Stanton for permission to collect donations for the family at Tuesday Nite Live. Amy's dedicated service to youth recreation in Johnson was noted.
