- We unanimously approved the minutes of the 7/28/14 meeting
- Archery – Nat began the search for qualified instructors for youth archery. No luck yet. He'll keep looking.
- Work continues on an online calendar. We'd like something other than Google calendar. Beth and Heather are going to research some options.
- We agreed to set the following registration deadlines:
 - Basketball registration from now until October 15th.
 - Put in Jag Journal
 - \$20 per child fee with a \$30 family cap
 - Refunds if parents volunteer for the tourney
 - \$10 for the k/pre-k
 - Ski and Ride registrations –
 - Register by Thanksgiving
 - We are willing to compensate this person \$10 per day reimbursement
 - Baseball registrations –
 - Registration deadline March 20th
 - \$20 for regular – \$30 family cap
 - \$10 for preschool and younger
 - We agreed to set fall 2015 soccer registration at a spring meeting.
- We approved the following as our mission statement:

- Amy is going to do research on getting Lacrosse going in Johnson, which would include other area towns. She believes that she can borrow equipment

and run the program at a very low cost. The committee is open to the idea of taking on lacrosse as a Johnson Rec activity.

- Beth is organizing the soccer tournament set for October 4th.
 - Nat will confirm the teams that will show up.
 - Denise will get refs
 - Beth and Amber Cheever will be in charge of refreshments
 - There will be lots of doughnuts
 - Nat will do parking but needs some helpers. Heather will look into getting some local exchange students to help out.
