Johnson Historical Society Monthly Meeting Minutes 13 September 2017 at 9:00 AM at the Holcomb House

Call to Order

Linda Jones called the meeting to order and two items were added to the agenda: a proposed visit from folks at Copley Manor and work sessions at the Holcomb House.

The minutes of August 9th were approved as printed.

Treasurer Tom Carney reported a balance of \$17,138.30 as of September 12, 2017. Linda reported Tuesday Night Live generated just over \$5,000 with more income from sale of excess product to be added.

Budget Report:

Two bills were authorized for payment, the Sheriff's Department at \$180 and Farm & Garden, Hardware and Rental at \$60.50.

Administrative items:

Museum Archive Software Project: Duncan Hastings shared his experience using a software package found on-line. It was moved, seconded and approved to adopt and use the museum archive software with Duncan taking the leadership role. A sub-committee will be formed to establish the protocols for using the system.

TNL Equipment & Supplies Storage: Following discussion, a number of potential storage areas for the TNL equipment were identified. Dean West and Tom will relocate the items. Appreciation was extended to Daryl West for again providing his trailer for storage throughout the TNL season.

Camera Proposal: Following discussion, it was moved, seconded and approved to authorize Tom to shop for a movie camera not to exceed \$250.

Holcomb House Hours for fall and winter will be Sunday afternoon from 1 to 4 PM and Thursday from 9 AM to noon with Thursday also being an in-house work morning.

Building Committee Report:

Front yard repair & steps: Brian and Duncan have a plan which should be accomplished soon.

Eaves project: Following discussion, is was moved, seconded and approved to ask the Selectboard to install a commercial gutter around the official entrance at the Holcomb House.

Lighting fixture follow-up: Dean reported the overhead light installed in the East Room is adjustable if needed. The light is from the Johnson Elementary School.

Storage area plans: The interior work continues with Duncan mudding and Dean sanding. It was suggested that paint can be purchased at the Restore for \$10 a gallon. Dean will announce work sessions.

Program/Projects:

Tuesday Night Live Wrap-Up: It was a successful season in spite of the inclement weather with one session stopped by lightning and thunder and one cancelled due to weather. With 30 pie and cake bakers, three potato salad makers, two hot dog grillers and the set-up & break-down team, the Historical Society's presence at Tuesday Night Live is a team effort. Thanks to all for volunteering and thanks to the community for supporting us.

Ruth Mould paintings: Insurance assessment in progress.

Johnson/JSC documentary: No update.

JHS role when town roads are being named: No update.

October 15th program: Planning is still in process, awaiting word from Eric Tobin. The drawing will take place at 3 PM. Duncan will provide a butter churn to use for the raffle drawing.

Jubilee – Buy Local program: The program will be held again this year with a new system for folks securing *visitor stamps*. Historical Society has been asked to do readings as in the past. Jane Marshall will be the story teller. More to follow.

Two 1915 license plates were added to the plate collection.

Other:

Dick asked about storage in the basement. The cellar is fairly dry presenting an opportunity for some storage if shelves are built. The coal bin contains a good amount of coal, which if removed would open up some dry space.

Frank encouraged the production of videos to record as much of Johnson's history as possible.

Dick asked about volunteers keeping track of in-kind contributions including Trustees and other volunteers. Dick reminded all that records of in-kind contributions can be a significant match for grants. Lois will look for forms developed for that purpose.

Linda distributed a thank you note to Trustees expressing appreciation for their contributions at Tuesday Night Live throughout the summer.
