



Please Help Protect the Sewer System

With the recent shortage of toilet paper and important focus on good hygiene, the use of paper towels, disinfecting wipes, and other cleaning products is understandably on the rise. However, the Village wants to remind our sewer customers **NOT to flush anything other than toilet paper.**

Toilet paper is made to disintegrate and our wastewater system is able to handle it. Disinfecting wipes, paper towels, and other similar materials, even those labeled as flushable, are thicker and are not designed to disintegrate like toilet paper. Flushing these items can result in clogged sewer lines and negatively impact wastewater plant operations, resulting in expensive repairs and service disruptions.

The Village therefore wants to remind the public that these items are **not flushable like toilet paper.** If you are using these alternatives to toilet paper, **please throw them in the trash and do not flush them.**
