Purpose of Meeting: Introduce FEMA staff to the committee and discuss the plan process.

## **Meeting Notes:**

- Introductions and meeting agenda shared.
- Paul Warden and Adrienne Parker were willing to co-chair this group.
- Paul reported that Randell spoke at Select Board providing information on what FEMA CA (Community Assistance) can provide related to assisting the town with a long-term recovery plan.
- Mark Leese (FEMA) provided overview and role of FEMA CA.
  - Long-term recovery plans are driven and developed by the town. It is a Town recovery plan not a FEMA plan.
  - Local government usually adopts the plan.
  - Identifying and describing 1 or maybe two projects max so town can more easily identify and go after funding opportunities.
  - Role of FEMA is to assist community in process.
- Mark will be attending joint meeting (Select Board and Village Trustees) on October 30<sup>th</sup> to describe FEMAs role and answer questions.
- Questions were asked about what a Long-term Recovery plan looks like and time frame of process.
- General discussion on flood modeling and need to better understand work being done and how this impacts discussions and decisions of work moving forward.
  - Johna Keefe will contact Peter with Agency of Natural Resource (ANR) to see if an overview can be given to this group.
- Questions were raised about building codes in the future and how this could help with town reaching future desired outcomes.
- Question was raised about defining downtown boundaries.
- Question was raised about EDA funding and who can apply for it. Only for Non-profit and Governmental entities.

- Question was raised as to what funding is available to small businesses. Mark Leese informed group we have a staff that can help identify funding once projects are defined.
- Next agenda items could include:
  - 1) Flood Modeling overview from ANR/other
  - 2) Start process of paring down long list of ideas to 1 or 2 projects
  - 3) Grant Funding Overview/Opportunities (Garrett Ellison, FEMA)
