



Final Construction Update and End-of-Season Survey Announcement Cambridge-Johnson STP 2925(1) [Cambridge-Johnson VT 15 Resurfacing Project]

DATE: Friday, November 22, 2024

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: From Monday, November 25, to Wednesday, November 27, between 6:30 a.m. and 5 p.m., crews will be on-site working outside of the roadway on VT 15, from just east of VT 100C in the Village of Johnson to the VT 15/VT 108 roundabout in Cambridge, with no anticipated impacts to traffic.

The speed limit reductions for the project limits will be lifted next week. Motorists are advised to follow the posted speed limit and travel with caution.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: Next week, crews will be on-site, working outside the roadway to conduct general cleanup and covering temporary traffic control signs to prepare the project area for the winter shutdown.

This is the final Construction Update for this construction season. Construction activities will resume in spring 2025.

LOCATION: Vermont Route 15 from the VT 15/ VT108 junction in Cambridge, continuing 9.1 miles to a point east of the VT 100C intersection in the Village of Johnson.

PROJECTED COMPLETION: Fall 2025
